TOPIC : Mucormycosis: An Emerging Challenge in COVID-19

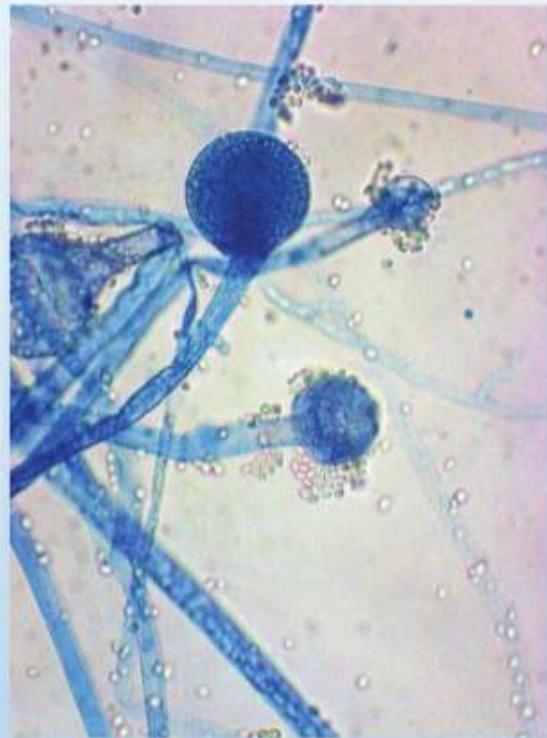
