

Both residents and faculty should be familiar with this often overlooked facet of labor. To address this gap, the Obstetrics and Gynecology department collaborated with the Anaesthesiology department to educate and deliberate on labour analgesia. Dr. Megha Sonawane, a Senior Anaesthesiologist, guided us through the historical evolution and recent advancements in labor analgesia. The session was highly informative, and the subsequent constructive discussion underscored the importance of offering our patients choices in analgesia during labor. Unanimously, the participants recognized this need, paving the way for the inclusion of Epidural anesthesia for our antenatal women. This well-attended session comprised residents and faculty from both Obstetrics and Gynecology and Anaesthesiology departments. Future plans include organizing more integrated teaching sessions between the departments.</p>
