Under the leadership of Dr Vaishali Korde, Professor & HOD, the Department of OBGY (Labour & OT complex) underwent the assessment for the prestigious 'Manyata Accreditation by FOGSI (Federation of Obstetrics and Gynecology Society Of India). Over the last few months, the labour room staff had undergone rigorous training, both via lectures and hands-on skills training by Dr Aparna Shrotri, Dr Sana & Dr Ronge (Manyata Trainers from Gupte Hospital). MIMER coordinator, Dr Meenakshi Surve along with Sister in Charge Mrs Madhuri Patil & Mrs Vaishali Londhe, took great efforts to coordinate these sessions and upgrade the labour room complex, antenatal ward, postnatal ward and operation theatre following the Manyata guidelines. The concerned certificate will be received soon. 
Assessment for NATIONAL PROGRAM "LAQSHYA" is due in November & we are sure our staff will perform well in that too.







Staff showing the Emergency Trays
