



COMMENTS REGARDING CAMP

A multidisciplinary camp was organized by MIMER Medical college & BSTR Hospital, Talegaon Dabhade.

This camp was in Vihirgaon, Maval - EKVIRA DEVI CHAITRA NAVRATRA YATRA
Appropriate camp arrangements were done and a camp was conducted successfully on 07/04/22.

OBGY patients were attended to by Dr. Varsha Kumbhar, Junior Resident (Dept. OBGY)

Around 25 patients were seen by Dr. Varsha of which 08 patients were antenatal mothers, 2 were postnatal mothers and rest were females with gynaec related problems.

Antenatal care was given, investigations were done as part of routine screening, appropriate treatment plans advocated.

Gynaec patients were motivated to undergo PAP smear examination and referred to our hospital for the same.

Our team of doctors utilized the opportunity to encourage mothers for contraception.

Dr. Varsha and her team counselled all the mothers attending the newborn care clinic held at the camp .

The mothers were motivated to use contraception (temporary/ permanent).

One Gynec patient and 1 full term previous LSCS patient was referred to Talegaon BSTR Hospital for further management.
