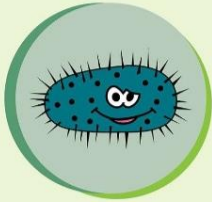

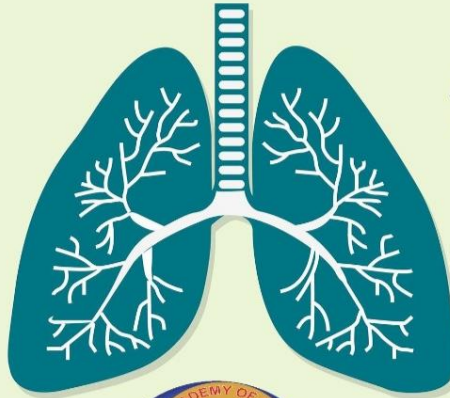
FACTS ON PNEUMONIA
