

- 4. Abstract should have sections on -Background, Methods, Observation & Results, Conclusion and Key words (3-5).
- 5. Case report- should have sections on Background, Case Report, Conclusion & Keywords (3-5) with word limit 250-300 words.
- 6. Oral Paper (offline and online) and e-poster (offline and online) presentation is limited to faculty and residents
- 7. Name, designation, department and name of the Institute of author and Co-author should be mentioned.
- 8. Name of the presenter to be underlined.
- 9. Email ID and mobile number of the presenter to be mentioned.
- 10. Please rename your word document as Author Name_ paper/poster_ online/ offline_faculty/resident whichever is applicable.
- 11. Please send the abstract to **conference@mitmimer.com** on or before 5pm of 20th November 2024.
