

They demonstrated both *positive communication* (showing empathy, active listening, clear explanations, and respect for patients and families) and *negative communication* (using jargon, being dismissive, lacking eye contact, or ignoring concerns). This interactive activity helped students recognize the impact of communication on patient trust and outcomes. After the play, students were asked to give reviews, reflecting on what worked well and what didn't, reinforcing learning through observation and feedback.
