Evidence-based management strategies and the pivotal role of nurses in surveillance and care escalation were emphasized. The second session addressed needle stick injuries, highlighting preventive measures, safe sharps handling, post-exposure management protocols, and the importance

		of prompt reporting. Both sessions highlighted patient safety and occupational safety in nursing practice.
