Brief summary of the event in around 100 words (purpose, conduct, feedback, impact, suggestions)	<p>A CME on <b>Breastfeeding and Lactation</b> was organized at on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025 on the theme “Prioritize Breastfeeding: Create sustainable support system.” The session was specially designed for doctors, MBBS students, <b>nurses, nursing students, and healthcare workers</b>, with the aim of strengthening their knowledge and skills in promoting and supporting optimal breastfeeding practices. The CME was addressed by <b>International Board-Certified Lactation Consultants (IBCLC’s)</b>, who shared their expertise on various aspects of lactation management. There were 8 sessions on breastfeeding and lactation. Key topics included the importance of early initiation of breastfeeding, counselling techniques for mothers, management of common breastfeeding difficulties, and the role of healthcare providers in sustaining exclusive breastfeeding for the first six months. The sessions were interactive, encouraging participants to discuss challenges faced in their day-to-day practice. Nurses and healthcare workers gained practical insights and evidence-based strategies to better support mothers in overcoming barriers to successful breastfeeding.
