



**Mode of Action**

- A selective estrogen receptor modulator and has tissue selective estrogenic or anti-estrogenic effects.
- It suppresses the estrogen receptor in the reproductive organs like ovaries, uterus and breasts but stimulates those of other organs like the bones.
- The contraceptive effect is due to prevention of implantation of the fertilized ovum through local action on the uterine environment, the HPO axis remaining unaffected.
