Brief summary of the event in around 100 words (purpose, conduct, feedback, impact, suggestions)	<p><u>Purpose:</u> The session aimed to enhance awareness among pregnant and post-natal women along with their relatives regarding iron deficiency anemia—its risks, prevention strategies, and appropriate management—to promote better maternal and fetal health outcomes.</p> <p><u>Conduct of the Session:</u> A health talk was organized on the occasion of Iron Deficiency Awareness Day in the PNC ward, with participation from 50 pregnant women and their accompanying relatives. The session was delivered by Dr. Shashikant Pawar, Head of Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology along with Dr. Sushma Sharma & Dr. Jintendra Mane . He covered key aspects such as: The role and importance of iron during growth spurt in girls, young women aspiring to be mothers, pregnancy, Perimenopause and Menopause. Common dietary sources rich in iron were exemplified Correct use of iron supplements was explained Potential complications arising from untreated anemia was discussed The session concluded with an interactive question-and-answer segment, allowing attendees to clarify doubts and discuss individual concerns. Similar session was conducted in the OBGY OPD by Dr. Jintendra Mane, Professor in Dept of OBGY where in 40 participated were benefited by the talk.</p> <p><u>Feedback:</u> Participants expressed that the talks were highly informative and engaging. They appreciated the practical guidance on improving daily iron intake and recognized the relevance of the topic to their health. Several attendees also showed keen interest in joining similar educational sessions in the future and will inform their keen about the knowledge they received from today's educational talks.</p>


