



Brief summary of the event in around 100 words (purpose, conduct, feedback, impact, suggestions)	<p>An Orientation lecture on antimicrobial and Diagnostic Stewardship was delivered by Dr. Vibhavari Barhate on 21/06/20/25 at 2.30 pm at Seminar Room in Dept. of Ophthalmology. A total of 11 PG residents and 4 interns attended the session.</p> <p>The session focused on key aspects of rational antibiotic use, the growing challenge of antimicrobial resistance, and the importance of accurate and timely diagnostic testing. Key topics included the principles of antimicrobial stewardship (AMS), diagnostic stewardship (DS) institutional AMS strategies, antibiotic policy and the role of doctors in implementing stewardship practices. She also discussed surgical antimicrobial prophylaxis for intraocular ocular and extraocular surgeries</p>
