It's transmitted through the bite of an infected Aedes mosquito. Prevention involves eliminating mosquito breeding sites, using repellents, and wearing protective clothing. Treatment focuses on supportive care, including rest, hydration, and pain relief medication, with close monitoring for signs of severe dengue. Severe cases can lead to bleeding, organ failure, and death. Prompt medical attention is essential.
