(3)With reference to letter from university regarding Revised PG Theory and Practical examination

It was unanimously decided

No change in conduction of Theory examination In PG exam .

Few of changes in practical examination

A) Proposed Changes in M.S. Ophthalmology Practical Examination as per proposal by Dr. Ajit Joshi Professor in Ophthalmology suggestion was accepted by Chairman to implement new pattern of MS ophthalmology examination as per NMC guidelines i.e.one long,two short fundus and two short external cases will be implemented from Dec 21/ Jan 22. The same has been discussed with HOD pune, sangli and chairman BOS.

B)long case marks in PG orthopedics practical Examination was discussed but as per opinion by external expert same marks(150) will be kept

C) In Anesthesia PG practical Examination printing mistake was accepted in practical Mark sheet.

Correction : Long case as 100 marks and 50 marks will be added to thesis mark in the practical mark sheet.

D) 50 marks in General surgery,Anaesthesia and Ortho PG examination for thesis will be divided as 30 marks for discussion on topic of thesis and 20 marks will be for ward round / viva voce.

(3) CBME curriculum for UG

Issue regarding internal assessment,log book and surgery allied marking system and paper pattern was raised by Dr Madhura Killedar

A) It was decided Logbook, Logbook for elective and journal these 3 books , will be separately designed and will be printed by the Sangli and Pune Medical Colleges as per NMC guidelines .

B) Chairman added point that as per discussion with NMC authority ,It was decided to conduct only practical Examination (instead of theory+practical as per NMC guidelines) at the End of each practical Posting .

C) In Surgery Theory Orthopedics and allied will be in paper 1

Dr.Abhijeet Tilak (Ext. expert) and Dr.P.S.Salve (Member) were absent due to prior commitments.






- 1) Minutes of previous meeting were unanimously confirmed
