One of our PG student in Dermatology Dr. Aryaman Singh Kanwar has presented a paper at an International Conference in Germany .

Our MBBS students are also having student research council which is functioning well under guidance of department of clinical research. This year 11 MBBS ICMR projects have been completed successfully. Yesterday only our colleges have conducted MUHS Annual Research Conference in which 18 MBBS students’ projects have been approved.

Our Institute is having UNESCO Bioethics Haifa Chair. In Nov 2018; there was UNESCO Bioethics Conference in Jerusalem. Out of only 2 international award for outstanding contribution to bioethics ,one is received by MIMER.

This year 5th International Rhinoplasty Workshop was organized by MIMER Medical College from 14 to 16 Feb 2019 under skilled guidance of course Director Dr Virendra Ghaisas, a premier & international renowned ENT surgery of Pune city. Workshop was conducted in our Anatomy Dept. where Dr. Virendra Ghaisas demonstrated step by step surgical procedure on fresh cadaver; followed by hands on training to 14 delegates. 2 delegates were from Nepal & Iraq. In all 250 delegates all over the world attended the conference.

Livesurgery demonstration was at Hotel JW Marriot Pune which was attended by 240 delegates from all over world i.e. four Nepal, Bangladesh Prof Dr Wolfgang & Dr. Sebastian from

Germany & Prof Dr. Yong from Korea along with Dr. Virendra Ghaisas demonstrated 10 live surgeries. It was really a good experience.

We have got very advanced Central Research Lab; where Dr. Banerjee & Mr. Patil are doing high degree research work on cancer cell Nano technology. This year department of science and technology gave funding of 41.59 lakhs for their project.

The institute has provided funding of Rs.11000/- as financial support for presenting paper at 2 State and 1 National level conference. Funding of Rs.20000/- each was given to 2 research projects of community projects, 2 research projects of OBGY ,2 research projects of Biochemistry and that of Rs.5000/- was given to department of pediatrics from the research society of the institute this year.

7th Annual conference of research society was held in December 2018. The theme of the conference was “ **Nutrition – Creating Healthier Lives.**”Dr.J.V Dixit professor community medicine and renowned dietician was the chief guest for the conference

Research activities:

This year Institute submitted 17 ICMR- STS projects and 3 MUHS projects of MBBS students of which 11 ICMR 1 MUHS project got approved.

In order to promote research the Institute has given financial support of Total Rs.22600/- to faculty who presented their paper at 1 International,3 National level and 3State level conferences.
