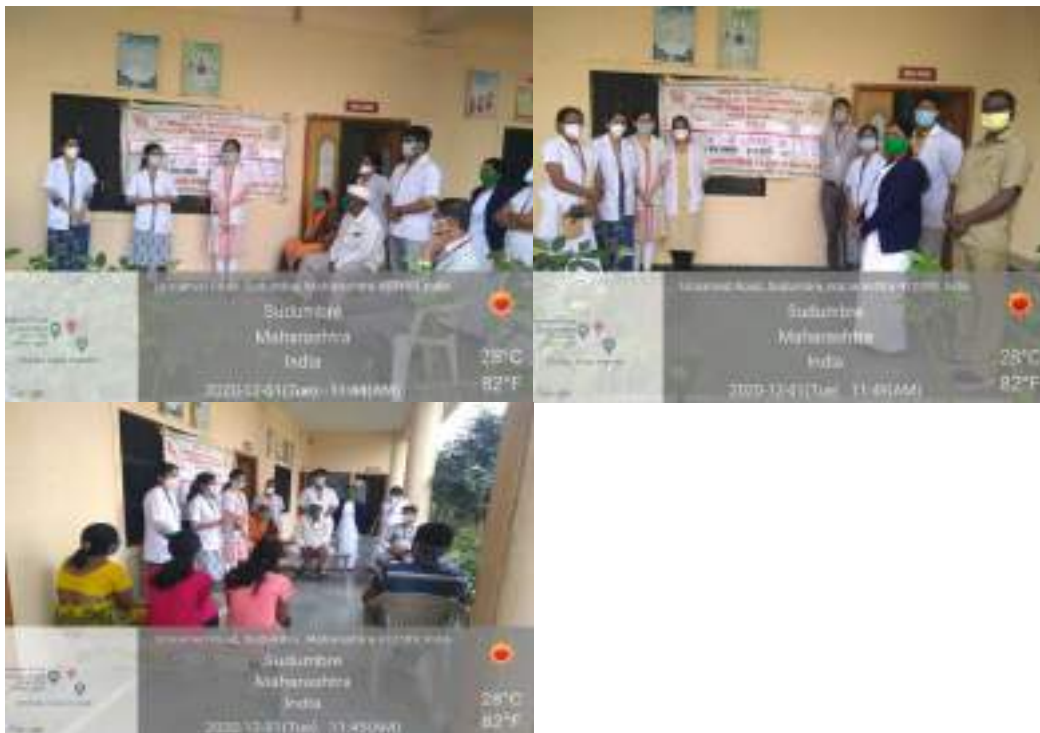

## 1. Health camp Held on 12/01/2021 at Nanoli Village

Department of Community Medicine organized a Haemoglobin check up camp on 12th January 2021 for residents of Nanoli Village. The Haemoglobin level of 150 residents was checked. Free Iron and Folic acid tablets were given to those with low Hb levels and they were advised to eat foods rich in iron and have a balanced diet. A follow up is planned after three months.

Patients were also given free medications such as Calcium tablets, Paracetamol, Antacids etc. Patients requiring further management were referred to Bhausahab Sardesai Talegaon Rural Hospital.

We assured the villagers that such visits would be conducted twice every month. And in case of any health issue, they could contact the respective student.





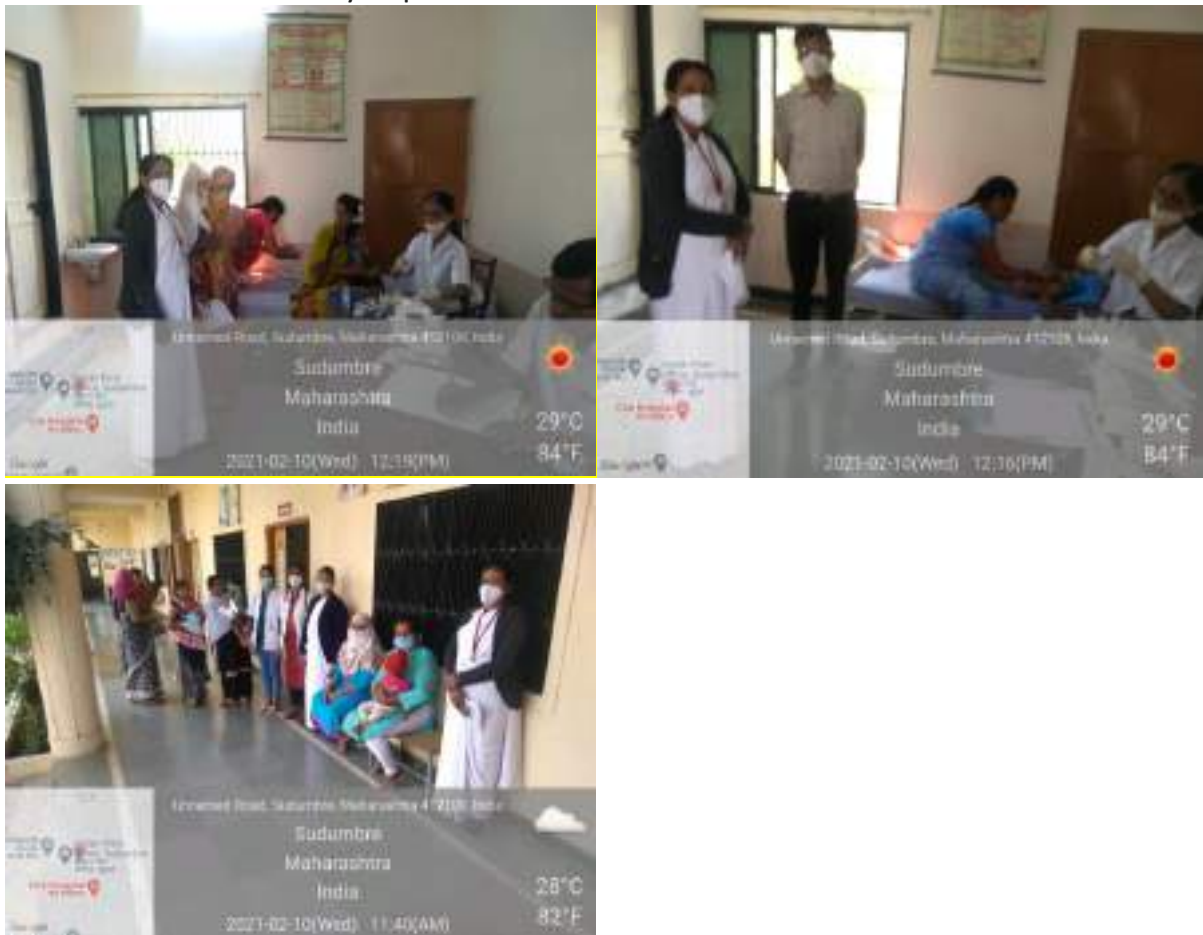


## RHTC, Sudumbare Immunization Report
