The community medicine department regularly conducts community based teaching learning activities which help the students develop empathy.



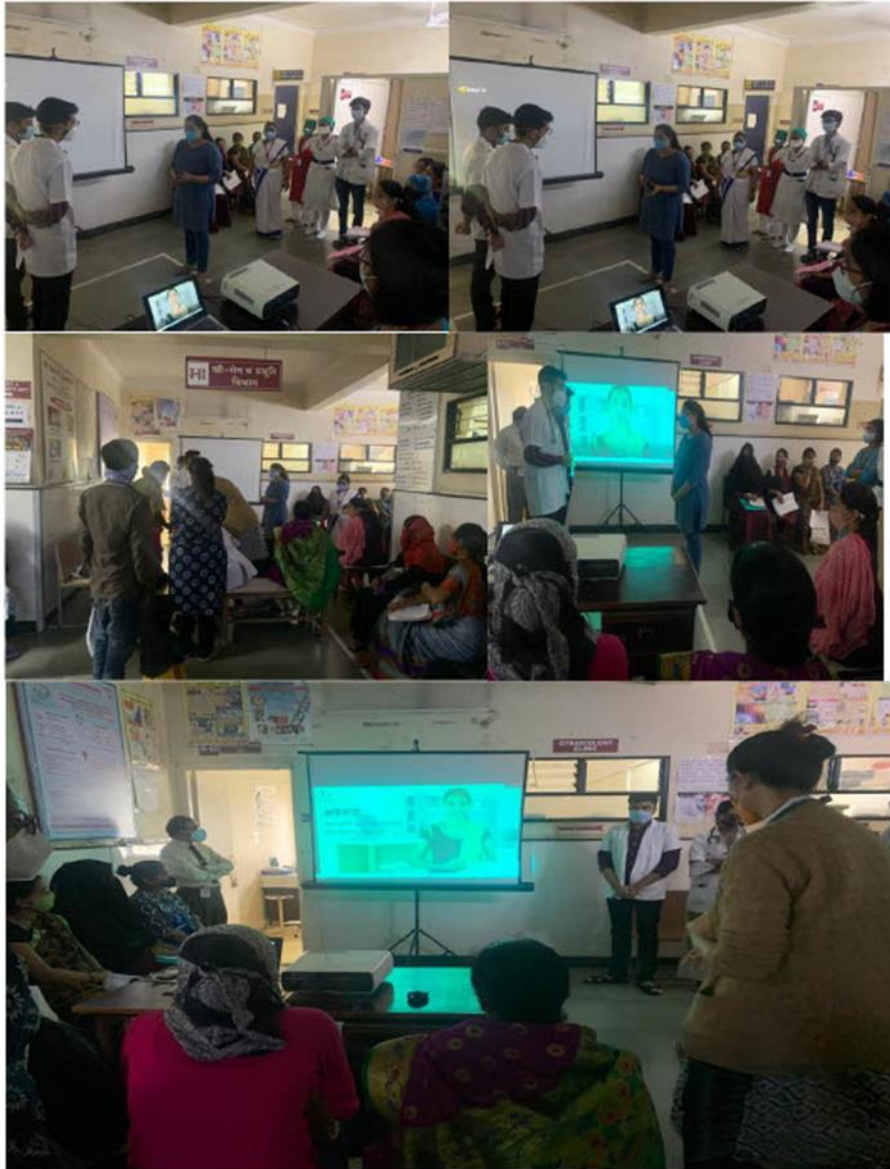

In the year between 1st august 2019 to 31st Sept 2020, many programmes were conducted to enhance the skills of the students-both undergraduate and postgraduates.

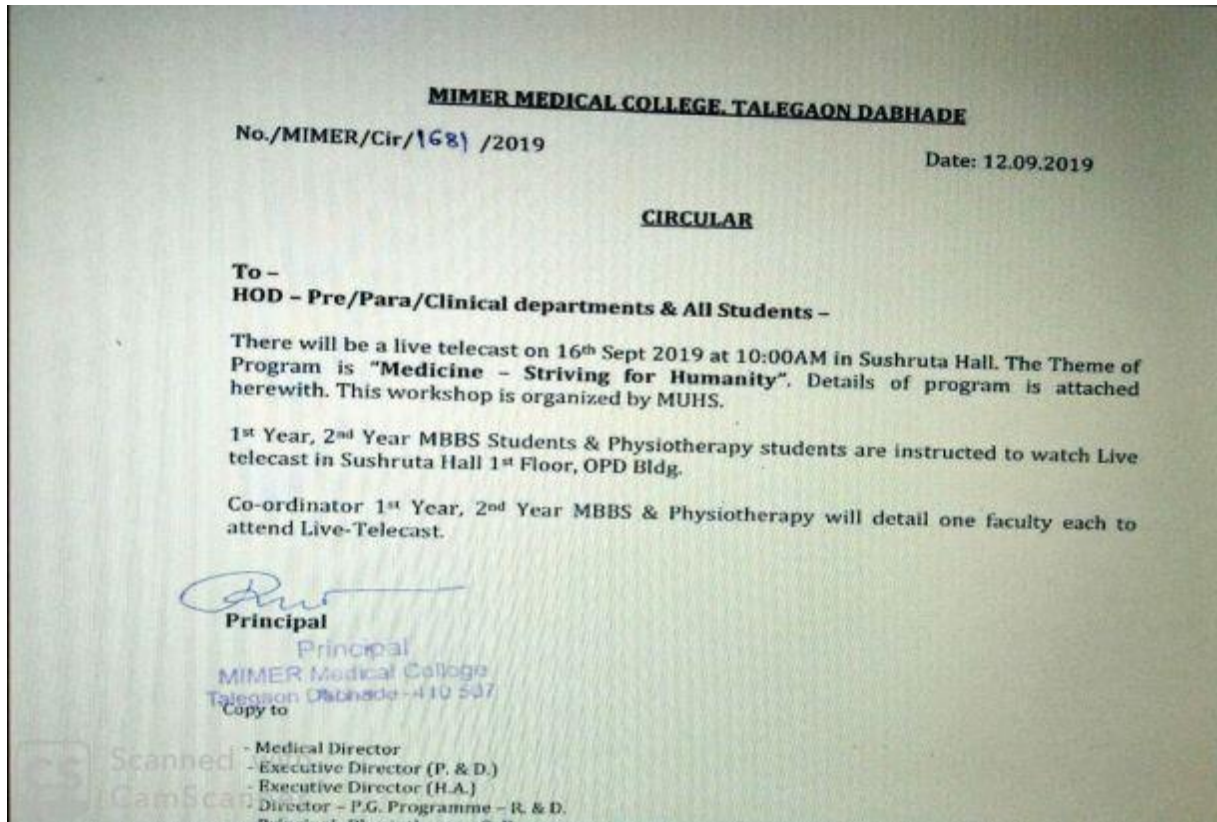

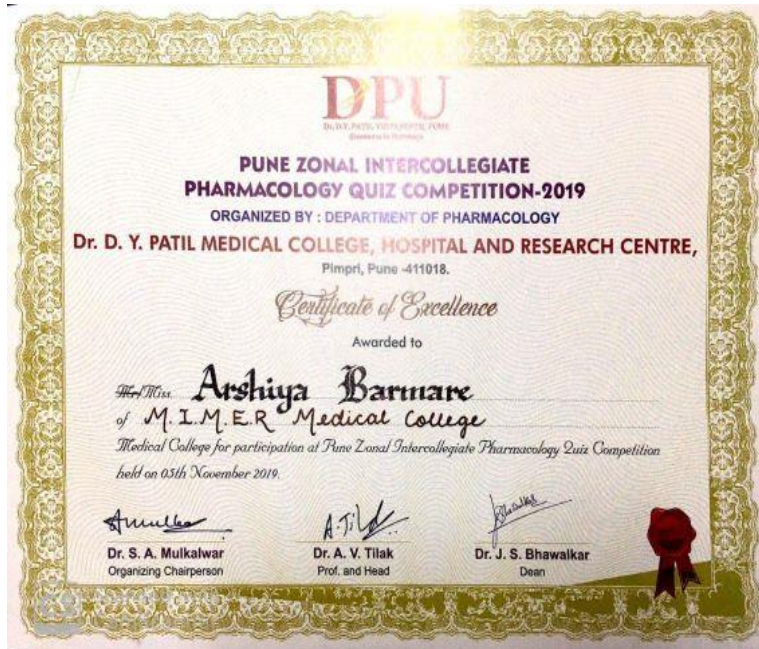

We at MIMER Medical College, take pride in producing students who are well versed to deal with the competitive world after graduating from here. The students are nurtured by various ways to enhance their skills be it technical or soft skills for their personal and professional development.

SOFT SKILL DEVELOPMENT
