5. Health camp Held on 12/01/2021 at Nanoli Village

Department of Community Medicine organized a Haemoglobin check up camp on 12th January 2021 for residents of Nanoli Village. The camp was presided over by Sarpanch of Nanoli Tarf, Dr. Sanjeev Chincholikar (HOD Dept of Community Medicine) and Dr. Ratna Majumdar (Professor). A total of 159 residents attended the camp. The Haemoglobin level of 150 residents was checked. Free Iron and Folic acid tables were given to those with low Hb levels and they were advised to eat foods rich in iron and have a balanced diet. A follow up is planned after three months.

Patients were also given free medications such as Calcium tablets, Paracetamol, Antacids etc. Patients requiring further management were referred to Bhausaheb Sardesai Talegaon Rural Hospital.

The camp was a huge success with overwhelming response from the residents of Nanoli village.

The winners were given cash prize, Trophy and a book as token of appreciation. The books were sponsored by J.P Publication.






WORLD NO TOBACCO DAY 31ST MAY,2019



On the 2_{nd} day, after finishing of the practice session, the age verification was done for 100 boys and girls from Sub-junior and Junior categories with the help of the dentist from our team. Also the cases of oral ulceration and toothache were given medication by the dentist.

All the casualties were given proper attention and medical support by the doctors available in our team. The food was provided by the organizers. The vehicle assistance in the form of well equipped ambulance was provided by the MIMER Medical College and hospital. Medications were also supplied by MIMER Medical College and Hospital, Talegaon Dabhade. There were no serious or major casualties during this event.




FREE DIAGNOSTIC CAMP AT SUDUMBRE ON OCCASION OF "JAGNADE MAHARAJ SAPTAH"
