Minutes of Meeting of IQAC held on 7th August 2023

Meeting chaired by Dr. Suchitra Nagare Madam

1. Minutes of Meeting of last IQAC meeting held on 31st May 2023 was confirmed by Dr Smita Bhide.
2. Dr Janice Jaison said that our institution has received ISO 9001: 2015 certification on 28/7/23 which is valid for a period of 3 years.
3. Dr Sandhya Kulkarni said that we have received an appreciation letter from MUHS for Digital evaluation of scripts of PG Medical Examinations (Summer 2023) Institutes which evaluated more than 500 answer sheets have been awarded with the appreciation letter.
4. Dr Janice Jaison said that the AQAR period is 1st June 2022 to 31st August 2023. Monthly reports have been received till June 2023 from all the Depts. Few depts have submitted monthly report for the month of July. Criteria wise meetings have been planned. Dr Suchitra Nagare Madam instructed Dr Gopalghare and Dr Sushma Chavan to attend meeting and give inputs of the workshop attended by them at MUHS Nashik.
5. Dr Sandhya Kulkarni told the criteria heads to review documents kept in NAAC room. All original documents prepared with principal signature are to be kept in NAAC room in Criteria wise files.
6. Dr Sushma Chavan briefed about Parent Teacher meeting. Parents to be intimated about parent teacher meeting by WhatsApp group in addition to the email. Dr Suchitra Nagare Madam instructed that Parent Teacher meeting should be conducted for Phase III and Phase IV also. Medicine department to conduct parent teacher meeting.
7. Dr Janice Jaison said that some parents had raised issues about the quality of water supply in the hostels. Dr Suchitra Nagare madam said that details to be asked to the hostel wardens and details of cleaning of tanks etc to be reviewed.
8. Dr Vaishali Korde briefed about feedback obtained from stakeholders. She said feedback has been collected on TCSiON but analysis could not be done as data obtained in excelsheets. Dr Suchitra Nagare madam instructed to get the analysis done at the earliest.
9. Dr Deepa Nair briefed about GMER 2023. 100 marks to be assigned to home assignment, seminar, library assignment etc and 10 marks for attendance also. There is change in the passing criteria also. Change in MCQ pattern has also been done by MUHS. Dr Suchitra Nagare madam said that a letter needs to be sent to NMC regarding the difficulties encountered in the pattern and how the quality of medical education will suffer by reducing the criteria of passing percentage from 50% to 40%. She also instructed that all departments should conduct MCQ tests as per new format so that the students have enough practice regarding the same.
10. Dr Janice Jaison briefed about incentives provided for academic course or quality assurance courses. Dr Suchitra Nagare madam said that the departments should encourage teaching and nonteaching staff to avail this facility. She also said that a we should also provide incentives to the undergraduate students for academic and sports activities. The slabs for the incentives will be according to the level of participation- local, state, national and international. Dr Janice Jaison said that there were queries regarding providing grants for pg thesis. Dr Suchitra Nagare madam said that for PG thesis, where lab tests is involved, the students will purchase the kits and give the concerned department. Dr Aneesh mentioned that PG students can apply for MUHS grant or research grants. Dr Tushar Kachane, Dr

Sandesh Gawade and Dr Sushma Sharma said that the R and D cell can discuss about this issue.

11. Dr Suchitra Nagare madam said that the agenda for IQAC meetings should include points related to initiatives, enhancement and sustenance undertaken at the institutional level.
12. Dr Gopalghare briefed about relevant points pertaining to improving data collection for AQAR discussed at the RAF NAAC workshop conducted by MUHS at Nashik on 16th June 2023. Dr Aneesh mentioned that Hospital Management and Hospital economics can be a best practice.
13. Dr Suchitra Nagare madam asked about the frequency of the internal academic and administrative audit. She said that it should be conducted under the leadership of Dr Gupta Sir.
14. Dr Vaishali Korde suggested that the institution should publish a IQAC newsletter following the submission of AQAR as done by some institutes.
